OLD BUSINESS: **NEW ENGINE 5469:** Deputy Chief John Thomen was absent. Division

Chief Eric Alvarez reported to the board that engineers and staff have been training on the engine. Two engineers have to make up the class. Engineer Harry So informed the board that everything works because

he has been driving Engine 5469.

FEE SCHEDULE: Division Chief Eric Alvarez reported he is working with Michelle on Nexis Study information. Blair Aas cannot assist with his schedule, but he has recommended another company that may be able to help. Michelle will contact the other

company.

TRAINING REPORT: Training Officer Jeff Donaldson was not in attendance.

Engineer Harry So reported the next drill on June 25th will be a wildland operation. July 3rd will be the next EMT class. There were 62 calls in May and 318 to date. Recently, a structured triage at String Creek was performed. Division Chief Alvarez stated it is a great way to learn about areas and access. Many properties have fire fill signs, which is extremely helpful. Homeowners willing to help the fire department with water are a great resource.

FIRE MARSHAL: Division Chief Eric Alvarez stated that before businesses sign a lease, they should contact the fire department and the City of Willits to get an idea of what they need to be compliant with, such as fire extinguishers and a business license. Division Chief Alvarez is working with the City of Willits regarding these issues. Additional sprinkler plans came in, but it was not a big enough project to justify a third-party review.

FIREFIGHTERS' ASSOC. REPORT: Harry So informed the board that August 10th is the 96th annual Volunteer Firefighter Association fundraiser. Tickets are currently being sold around town. This year, the association is not mailing out tickets due to the cost of mailing, which is a few thousand dollars. The car show had a great turnout, and the association hosted a pancake breakfast on Father's Day for EMS, law enforcement, and neighboring fire departments.

CHIEF'S REPORT: Deputy Chief John Thomen was not in attendance. Harry So reported that Brush Truck 5461 had a recall fixed recently in Petaluma, and Eric Alvarez noted that the new 5401 is waiting on a lighting package.
