# RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE #89-1 OF THE LITTLE LAKE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, COUNTY OF MENDOCINO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 6066 of the Government Code and Section 17951 of the Health and Safety Code, Fees for Services provided by Little Lake Fire Protection District and its Department of Fire Services, per SB515 and Chapter 8, Section 13916 through 13919 of Fire Protection District Law of 1987 shall be fixed as follows:

A fee in accordance with the following schedules shall be paid to the Fire District at the time of application or upon receipt of an invoice for services rendered.

The following services will be cost recovered using the Apparatus Hourly Fee Schedule.

- 1. Hazardous materials response
- 2. Standby for Fire Code and Health and Safety violations
- 3. Incidents involving illegal activities
- 4. Incidents resulting from negligence
- 5. Fire flow tests for development
- 6. False Alarms (third and subsequent false alarms within 30 days due to negligence,
- 7. Lack of maintenance, or failure to notify the alarm company of test or repair).
- 8. Control Bum stand-by
